- b) Entire Garden, over 2,500 sq metres, owner maintained
- c) Entire Garden, any size, professionally maintained
- d) Owner maintained Front Garden
OR Back Garden
- e) Small lot garden - site under 500 sq metres

2. New Garden

- Any size, under 3 years since established or major renovations undertaken, owner maintained.

3. Townhouse, Villa or Courtyard Garden

- Owner maintained

4. Senior Citizen's Garden— Owner maintained

- a) Entire Garden
- b) Front Garden **OR** Back Garden,
- c) Townhouse **OR** Courtyard Garden
- d) In a Retirement Village or Complex

5. Strata or Community Title Property

- Professionally maintained common property

6. Good Neighbour Gardens

- Two or more adjoining residential front gardens. All gardens must be individually entered

7. Specialty Garden

- a) Cottage, Australian Native, Vegetable, Outdoor Living Area or Modern/Contemporary
- b) Communal or Community Garden
- c) Environmentally or Bee Friendly Garden

8. Industrial, Commercial or Institution Garden

- Professionally maintained

9. School Gardens

- a) Small Garden area maintained by School students. (Primary or High School)
- b) Gardens maintained by school staff

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Judging will take place between 16th and 20th September. It will be necessary for our professional judges to visit your garden during this time. You will be advised on Sunday 15th September of your judging day.
2. The Awards Presentation Night will be held on Friday 27th September, in the Harvey Lowe Pavillion, Castle Hill Showground starting at 7.00 pm. Photos of the gardens will be shown from 7pm with the presentations beginning at 7.30. A light supper will be served at the conclusion of the presentations.
3. Prizes will be awarded in the above categories and the following awards will also be presented. It will not be necessary to apply for these Special Awards. All entries will be eligible.
 - a) **GEORGE ERIC MOBBS AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN GARDENING**
 - b) **CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS**
4. To be eligible to enter this competition, gardens must be located in The Hills Shire or in the adjoining parts of the suburbs of North Rocks, Carlingford, Northmead, Winston Hills, Baulkham Hills, West Pennant Hills, Cherrybrook, Glenhaven, Dural, Arcadia, Galston or Glenorie.
5. A maximum of 4 hours paid assistance per month for mowing or garden waste removal is permitted for owner maintained gardens.
